Topics: Clavicle ,Scapula

1. CLAVICLE:

- S-Shape, has
- Two ends. Medial end (Sternal), Lateral end (Acromial)
- Shaft Medial 2/3 convex anteriorly, Lateral 1/3 convex Posteriorly
- Two surfaces (Superior ,inferior)

Lower surface is Rough contains subclavius groove in the middle,
Laterally Conoid tubercle and Trapezoid ridge

2. SCAPULA:

- Triangular in shape, has
- Three angles. Superior, Inferior and lateral angles
Lateral angle called Glenoid cavity
 - Supra and infra glenoid tubercle
- Three borders. Superior border +Suprascapular notch, Medial and lateral borders
- Two surfaces and three fossae. Costal surface (Subscapular fossa)
Dorsal surface (Supraspinous & infraspinous fossas)
- Three processes.(Spinous , Acromion and Coracoid processes)
