



Interpeduncular Fossa

[Interpeduncular cisterna]


+ Branches of vertebral Artery






Middle cerebral Artery

Branches of I.C.A








- Rupture of Charchole Artery due to Hypertension

Will affect:

① Sensory: Spinal Laminiscus

② motor: Corticospinal

Contralateral
Hemiparesis + Hemianesthesia

- Genv has dual Blood Supply (MCA + from ICA)

If MCA is affected, No paralysis in Head + Neck area. [Corticobulbar fibers]
